During the 31st session of the UN Human Rights Council, the UN Special Rapporteurs presented their landmark report on the Practical Recommendations For The Management Of Assemblies. The UN HRC also adopted a follow-up resolution on the promotion and protection of human rights in the context of peaceful protests. (A/HRC/31/L.21)

This Side Event will provide substantive guidance on practical measures and best practices for the implementation of the recommendations and examine how the practical recommendations can be mobilized to support freedom of assembly in South Korea and Malaysia.

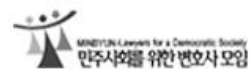
